Friendly, Safe and Age Appropriate Summer Activities

We provide a fun filled enriching summer program for the children of our surrounding communities as well as for St. Andrew's Nursery School. Our highly qualified staff is primarily teachers from St. Andrew's School (which brings wonderful continuity for the children) with some additional teachers from surrounding nursery schools, as well. We also employ college and high school students to help give the children more security and needed assistance throughout the day. Every staff member's primary focus is to create a safe, enjoyable and mentally stimulating camp experience. All teachers and staff have received abuse awareness training under the requirements of the Episcopal Diocese of New Jersey and our head counselors are CPR and First-Aid certified.

Primary Campers

4 - 7 year olds 5 - Day Program 9:00 AM to 1:30 PM

For 4-7 year olds who have turned 4 by June 15, 2010, up to children who have completed Kindergarten. Camp runs for nine weeks starting June 14th and ending August 13th. Extended Care is available from 7:30 in the morning until 5:00 in the afternoon after the normal camp hours. Tuition fees include a daily healthy snack, a camp T-shirt & lunch on Wednesdays.

Wee Campers

3 year olds 5 - Day Program 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM

For 3 year olds who have turned 3 by June 15, 2010, and are no longer in diapers. Camp runs nine weeks starting June 14th and ending August 13th. Extended Care for Wee campers starts at 12:00 p.m. and is available until 1:30 PM.

Special Needs

(Please note: No refunds will be granted for this reason.)

Registration

An application and a non-refundable registration fee of \$100.00 is required by April 1st to hold a placement. This fee is applied towards the tuition fee. Placements are offered on a first come, first serve basis. Full payments are due by April 15th. Payments received after April 15th will be subject to a \$25.00 late fee. Tuition fees are non-refundable.

The Camp reserves the right to fill any placement not paid in full by May 1st.

Camp Environment

We expect that each child will contribute to the safe and supportive learning environment that we will provide at St. Andrew's Action Campers 2010. Any consistent inappropriate behavior will necessitate a private conference with the child and his/her parent(s). If the negative behavior continues and the child becomes a danger to themselves and/or other children at camp; it will result in dismissal from camp. Tuition will not be refunded.
